

PIGMENTS OF PROVENCE REGISTRATION AGREEMENT

Thank you for your interest in our trip to France. We are very excited about the itinerary and activities and are looking forward to a wonderful time touring and learning through some of the most beautiful parts of this very special country. The following information comprises our Terms and Conditions for our tour. Welcome aboard!

TOUR DATES: OCTOBER 11-21, 2013. NOTE: Please plan on departing the US on October 11 to join the tour in Lyon on October 12.

PAYMENT AND RESERVATIONS

The total cost of the trip is \$6995. A payment of \$3497.50 per traveler and signed Registration Agreement will confirm your place on our trip. We accept Paypal, money orders, personal or cashiers checks in US dollars. We do accept credit card payments other than through Paypal.

The balance \$3497.50 is due on July 1, 2013. If you register within 90 days of the tour departure date, the full balance is due at time of registration.

The price of the tour includes the following:

- Double occupancy accommodations in centrally located 3 and 4 star boutique hotels
- All breakfasts, 2 lunches, our welcome and celebration dinners with wine
- Group transfer from hotel to Avignon TGV to return to Paris CDG Airport
- First class train transportation as described in the itinerary including TGV Train from Paris CDG Airport to Lyon
- All ground transportation to events in the itinerary
- English speaking guides with deep knowledge of the area and sites of special interest to our group.
- Driver and guide gratuities
- Tuition for cooking and art classes
- All art materials to be used in class
- Exclusive private fully equipped workshop facility at Okhra Conservatoire des Ochres et de Couleurs
- Admission to all museums and events on itinerary
- Pre-trip online class with John to introduce the textile techniques we will be learning as well as answer any questions about the trip.
- A handmade and hand-bound journal with tipped-in pages for your creative artwork and for serendipitous creative impulses as we take our tour.

Not included in the cost of the tour are:

- Air fare
- Single supplemental room charges
- Travel and trip cancellation insurance
- Medical expenses
- Laundry and dry cleaning
- Personal expenses
- Alcohol, beverages, food and snacks not covered on the itinerary

CANCELLATIONS AND REFUNDS

Due to the small tour size and highly personalized itinerary, we are unable to accommodate cancellations and provide refunds. We strongly suggest that you purchase trip cancellation and interruption insurance should your plans change.

If we cancel the trip, all payments will be fully refunded. Once we refund all monies paid, we have no other obligations to tour members on cancelled trips including any additional costs or fees related to the issuance and/or cancellation of airline tickets or other reservations not made by John Marshall and Kathy Hattori.

TRAVELING SINGLE

A very limited number of single supplements are available, as we will be staying in smaller boutique hotels. Single supplements are non-cancellable and non-refundable. If you are traveling alone but would like to room with another traveler, we will do our best to match you with a roommate.

SMOKING

This is a non-smoking tour; all of our hotels, classes, tour busses, automobiles and taxis are non-smoking.

LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

I acknowledge that no travel is without risk. Therefore, I acknowledge, understand and agree that John Marshall and Kathy Hattori (the Tour Operators)

- Are not liable for any loss, damage, injury or expense arising out of any accident to a person or to personal property due to any act or omissions by anyone associated, hired, retained or referred by the Tour Operators.
- Are acting only as the agent for the owners, contractors, and suppliers providing travel services and accommodations, and assume no responsibility or liability for injury, loss or damage to person or property in connection with any service resulting directly or indirectly from any defect in any vehicle, or through neglect or default of any company or person engaged in carrying out the tour or other purpose.
- In the event it becomes necessary or advisable for the comfort or well being of the passengers, for any reasons whatsoever, to alter the itinerary or arrangements, such

alterations may be made without penalty to the tour operators. Additional expenses, if any, shall be borne by the passengers.

- The tour operators are not responsible for strikes, thefts, medical problems encountered before, during or after the trip, force majeure, failure of any means for conveyance to arrive or depart as scheduled, civil disturbances, acts of terrorism, government restrictions or regulations, discrepancies or changes in transit or hotel or other services, over which it has no control. Baggage is at owners risk at all times.

TRAVELER'S RESPONSIBILITIES AND WAIVER OF RESPONSIBILITY

- Foreign Laws Apply: I acknowledge that I am traveling outside of the USA to a foreign country where the laws may vary and US Federal and/ or State regulations and standards in such areas as consumer protection, building access and safety and accommodations for those with physical disabilities or challenges do not apply. It is beyond the Tour Operator's ability to ensure that transportation and accommodations provided on tour meet these standards.
- I acknowledge that I am responsible for obtaining valid passports, visas, and any other documentation required by the country in which I will be traveling. I am responsible for obtaining and safeguarding my documents and luggage.
- I acknowledge that if I am unable to be at a designated meeting point at the time specified for any reason (including but not limited to airplane delays) that it is my responsibility to make alternate arrangements at my own expense to rejoin the tour.
- I acknowledge that I am physically capable of fully participating in this tour including the ability to carry or roll my own luggage up and down train station stairs, onto train platforms and lift my luggage into and out of train carriages. I am also physically capable of walking and standing and am comfortable on my feet in museums, and at monuments and other landmarks or sites that we visit. I also acknowledge that the weather may be rainy or cold and that I am physically capable to walk to sites, monuments and museums in varying weather conditions including hot sun and rain.
- I acknowledge that should I not be able to complete the tour for any reason that no reimbursement of fees is due me. NOTE: Trip cancellation and medical travel insurance is strongly advised.

I agree that upon advancement of deposit (or full fee if registering after July 1, 2013) and completed and signed Registration Agreement to John Marshall and Kathy Hattori that I will be bound to the terms and conditions stated above, and agree that John Marshall and Kathy Hattori will not be held responsible for accidental injury, death or other damage to anyone or personal property arising out of activities related to this trip.
